

# 2022 和富亞洲傑出家庭工作計劃簡介

追求創新、應用實踐、持續發展



亞洲傑出家庭工作計劃 (3A 計劃) 於 2010 年首屆成立，並每兩年舉行一次。3A 計劃一直得到和富社會企業全面贊助，為感謝和富社會企業對本計劃的支持，本計劃正式命名為「和富 3A 計劃」。

「和富 3A 計劃」旨在嘉許具創意的家庭工作手法或模式，俾能倡導、提升或改善亞洲家庭生活質素及功能。這個計劃的口號是「追求創新、應用實踐、持續發展」。在過去六屆比賽中，亞洲地區包括中國、香港、韓國、澳門、馬來西亞、星加坡及台灣所提交促進家庭功能的計劃，總數達 210 項。每屆和富 3A 計劃的八強隊伍均獲邀出席亞洲區家庭研究聯盟 (CIFA) 主辦的地區性研討會及分享會，讓隊伍到亞洲不同國家 / 地區如香港、日本、星加坡、上海、韓國及台灣等，與專業人士、學者、政府官員及社會賢達交流知識和經驗，分享推展家庭健康工作的心得。同時，CIFA 亦把各參賽計劃上載於 CIFA 網頁，並印製專刊、光碟、電腦記憶棒及展覽資料等，廣泛流傳及分派予專業人士、學者和機構，以供參考。

第七屆和富 3A 計劃將於 2021 年 12 月 10 日正式展開。有六屆卓越計劃的先例在前，和富 3A 計劃 2022 的參賽項目肯定更加精彩。

## 和富 3A 計劃 2022 的範疇

參賽計劃必須為原創，並運作了最少兩年時間（提交參賽計劃申請日期作準），內容可有關以下範疇：

- 1) 倡導及強化家庭功能
- 2) 鼓勵跨界別及跨專業合作
- 3) 支援有特別需要的家庭
- 4) 對抗不如意的家庭情況和社會排斥
- 5) 協助家庭持續發展、面對轉變及挑戰
- 6) 2019 冠狀病毒疫情對家庭的影響（如計劃與此有關，運作時間可少於兩年標準）
- 7) 其他有關改善及鞏固家庭的工作

\* 除以上獎項外，所有參賽隊伍所屬機構均可獲免費成為 CIFA 會員，並可享有以會員優惠報名參加於 2022 年 11 月 7-12 日期間在星加坡舉行的 CIFA 地區性研討會暨 MSF 亞洲家庭會議 2022。

\* 此外，八強隊伍均可獲津貼參加在星加坡舉行的 CIFA 地區性研討會暨 MSF 亞洲家庭會議 2022，出席當中舉行的和富 3A 計劃 2022 決賽及頒獎禮。星加坡隊伍的津貼為每人 \$200 美元資助，每隊津貼上限為 \$400 美元；非星加坡隊伍為每人 \$500 美元資助，每隊津貼上限為 \$1,000 美元。

## 獎項得主及八強隊伍的責任

- 1) 為延續和富 3A 計劃精神，所有獎項得主須提供得獎項目的持續評估數據，並跟進與其他機構 / 專業人士分享及交流知識與經驗的進展。
- 2) 所有得獎隊伍須出席於 2023 年於香港舉辦的交流會，分享他們的得獎項目和經驗。如有必要，CIFA 將提供津貼，資助有關海外隊伍參加交流會。
- 3) 金、銀、銅獎項得主須出席下一屆和富 3A 計劃（即和富 3A 計劃 2024）後於香港舉辦的交流會，並報告其項目進展。如有必要，CIFA 將提供津貼，資助有關海外隊伍參加交流會。
- 4) 所有八強隊伍須於決賽後六個月內提供一段視頻或有關獲獎項目的報告，以便製作和富 3A 計劃 2022 的電腦記憶棒。

# Wofoo Asian Award for Advancing Family Well-Being 2022

## Aspiration for Sustainability, Innovation & Applicability (ASIA)

### Introduction

The Asian Award for Advancing Family Well-Being (3A Project) was first launched in 2010 and repeated every two years. It is now known as the “Wofoo 3A Project” to acknowledge the full support from the Wofoo Social Enterprises (WSE) since project inception.

The Wofoo 3A Project is to give recognition to outstanding initiatives in the Asian region that have advanced an innovative idea, model, or paradigm that can improve the quality of life for families and enhance their well-being. The Project, with the spirit of “Aspiration for Sustainability, Innovation and Applicability” (ASIA), has so far attracted 210 submissions in total in the past six rounds of competition, from different Asian districts including China, Hong Kong, Korea, Macau, Malaysia, Singapore, and Taiwan. On all these occasions, eight finalist teams had the opportunity to present their projects at the CIFA Regional Symposiums and Exchange Programmes to share their knowledge, experience and good practice. Brochures, DVDs/USBs and display materials were produced and uploaded onto the CIFA WEP for wide distribution among professionals, academics and organisations.

The Wofoo 3A Project will be a major component of the CIFA Regional Symposium & MSF Asian Family Conference 2022 to be held in Singapore in the week of 7-12 November 2022, with its Final Round Adjudication and Award Presentation Ceremony as highlights of the Symposium.

### Objectives

The aim of the Wofoo 3A Project is to provide a platform to encourage sharing of valuable experience and practice wisdom while giving recognition to outstanding and pioneering work. It encourages the transfer of innovation and knowledge among professionals in different countries, ultimately contributing to the sustainable development of family well-being and strengthening of family functioning in the whole of Asia.

### Project Scope

Projects entering the competition should cover at least one of the following areas:

- Promote and enhance family functions
- Encourage cross-sector/professional collaboration
- Support families at special circumstances
- Confront adverse family situations and social exclusions
- Embrace changes for family sustainable development
- Cope with the impact of COVID-19 pandemic on families
- Any other areas related to family strengthening and betterment

### Eligibility

- Projects carried out by organisations or individuals promoting family well-being in the Asian Region.
- Each applicant may submit only one project, yet projects from different units/groups of the same organisation are acceptable.
- Projects that have run for at least two years before the date of submission of initial application. (This requirement may be lifted for projects responding to the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic.)
- Whether published or not, entries must be original.

### Selection Criteria

- Project rationale and social responsiveness
- Work approach, methodology and implementation process
- Effectiveness in enhancing family functioning and its achievements
- Innovation
- Sustainability and replicability
- Institutional synergy promoting multi-disciplinary or cross-cultural collaboration

### Adjudication

To assure high standing of the award, the Adjudication Panel comprises the Chairperson of CIFA, representative from the title sponsor, and respectable professionals and individuals in related fields. They are:

Mrs. Patricia Chu, Chairperson of CIFA;  
Ms. Virginia Chan, representative from Wofoo Social Enterprises (Title Sponsor);  
Ms. Bawany Chinapan, HELP University, Malaysia;  
Prof. Joyce Feng, National Taiwan University, Taiwan; and  
Prof. Yeong-Hee Kim, Chungbuk National University, Korea.

The result of the competition will be announced during the CIFA Regional Symposium & MSF Asian Family Conference 2022 held in the week of 7-12 November 2022 at the Award Presentation Ceremony. The announcement will also be publicised thereafter on the CIFA WEP.

### Deadline for Submission of Projects: 28 January 2022

(Please refer to the back of the Project Submission Form for details of the Application & Adjudication Procedures.)

### Awards and Prizes

There will be the Gold, Silver and Bronze Awards for the top winners. The other teams entering the Final Round Adjudication will also be honoured with Outstanding Awards. The “My Favourite Project” will be voted on spot by participants attending the Final Round Adjudication session at the CIFA Regional Symposium & MSF Asian Family Conference 2022. The “Best Collaborative Award” will give recognition to the project which demonstrates the most collaborative efforts among different disciplines and stakeholders to actualise the vision of “Converging Professional Wisdom for Family Well-Being”; the “Most Innovative Award” will give recognition to the project which is most creative and demonstrating pioneering spirit throughout the project; and the “Bringing Hope Home Award” will give recognition to the project which demonstrates most effort to enhance resilience and bring hope to the families in coping with the challenges brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Details of the awards and prizes are as follows:

\* Organisations submitting projects will become members of CIFA, and will enjoy the benefit of reduced registration fee for the CIFA Regional Symposium & MSF Asian Family Conference 2022 to be held in Singapore in the week of 7-12 November, 2022.

\* Among the eight finalists, teams from outside Singapore will be subsidised at US\$500 per person, up to a maximum of US\$1,000 per team, to attend the CIFA Regional Symposium & MSF Asian Family Conference 2022 to present their projects at the Final Round Adjudication and the Award Presentation Ceremony. Finalist teams from Singapore will be subsidised at US\$200 per person, up to a maximum of US\$400 per team.

### Responsibilities of the Project Winners and the Finalists

- To sustain the momentum of the Wofoo 3A Project, the award winners are expected to provide data for ongoing evaluation of the projects, and to track progress on the transfer of knowledge and experience to other organisations and professionals.
- All award winners are expected to join the Exchange Programme to be held in 2023 in Hong Kong, sharing their projects and experience with interested professionals, organisations and individuals. CIFA will provide subsidy to overseas teams to join the programme where necessary.

- Gold, Silver and Bronze Award winners are expected to join the Exchange Programme of the next Wofoo 3A Project (i.e. Wofoo 3A Project 2024) to be held in Hong Kong thereafter to share their project development. CIFA will provide subsidy to related overseas teams to join the programme where necessary.
- All finalist teams will be required to submit a video or an updated version of their project presentation at the Final Round Adjudication, within six months after the competition, for production of the Wofoo 3A Project 2022 USB.

### Declaration

- The decision of the Adjudication Panel is final and irrevocable. The organiser will not disclose the contents of the adjudicators’ deliberations.
- The finalist projects and results of the competition will be uploaded onto the CIFA WEP for public sharing of the valuable ideas and experiences. A USB will be produced for wider sharing.
- CIFA reserves the right to use the submissions for non-commercial purposes in promoting the Wofoo 3A Project and family work.
